



THANKSGIVING PHONE SCAVENGER HUNT

Thanksgiving is a time when we gather with family and friends to be grateful for all we have together. So while everyone is gathered, why not play a game? This scavenger hunt is a fun way to engage all ages while looking back on past blessings and cherished moments we may have overlooked or forgotten.

How to Play

1. Print the attached sheet for each person playing.
2. Choose someone to be the "Reader". They will read each of the items on the scavenger hunt aloud to the other players.
3. Each person should have a smartphone with them, as they are going to be looking for photos on their camera roll, social media, etc. for each prompt. If you have younger players who don't have their own phone, pair them with a parent or grandparent.
4. The "Reader" will read aloud one of the items on the attached sheet and each player will get 1–2 minutes (set a timer!) to find a photo on their phone that represents the phrase.
5. No taking new photos! The point of the game is to look back at all your memories and remember how wonderful those moments were.
6. When the time is up, every player gets to share their photo and should explain why they chose it.
7. Be sure to check off the scavenger hunt item if you found a photo on your phone to match it. The player with the most checkmarks (or best stories) wins.

Have fun! You'll be amazed how much you learn about each other (especially those relatives and friends you don't get to see often) and this game is a wonderful way to remember all the joy in your life from the little snapshots you chose to save!
